**Position:** Nurse Home Visitor/ Nurse Family Partnership

**General Description:** Position responsible for work planning, monitoring, evaluating, assessing, consulting, and teaching clients during home visits. Among other things, will be responsible for the below essential functions:

- Evaluate health trends and risk factors of population groups and help determine priorities for targeted interventions;
- Work with communities or specific population groups within the community to develop public policy and targeted health promotion and disease prevention activities;
- Participate in assessing and evaluating health care services to ensure that people are informed of programs and services available and are assisted in the utilization of available services.
- Provide health education, care management and primary care to individuals and families who are members of vulnerable populations and high risk groups.
- Complete annual updates on State Board of Nursing required practice protocols.
- Perform psychosocial and nursing assessments of NFP clients for the purpose of identifying problem areas, the needs and level of services within timeframes outlined by NFP Standards and Guidelines.
- Develop a Family Support Plan with the participant and family as indicated, upgrading at a minimum of every 90 days.
- Refer and follow-up on the receipt of services and coordinating, consulting, and collaborating with service providers.
- Teach and counsel on child care, pregnancy spacing, danger signs pregnancy pre-term labor, chronic disease management, high risk conditions of pregnancy, neonatal and pediatric intensive care infants.
- Document termination of case management services and transitional activities as appropriate

**Education:** Valid Florida RN license required; BSN preferred; ASN acceptable

**Experience:**

- 1-3 years in maternal and child health, behavioral health nursing, pediatrics, public health or other fields.
- 5 years high risk OB and/ or pediatric experience preferred
- Bilingual (English/Spanish)
- Proficient personal computer experience to include Microsoft Outlook, Word, Microsoft Outlook, Access, Excel, PowerPoint and Internet applications. Ability to communicate with a range of constituents, prioritize work effectively in a fast-paced, deadline-oriented office environment. Excellent interpersonal and writing skills.
